

Murón 954 2023 – High-Altitude Vineyards

Red wine aged for 6 months

Origin

This red wine is made from 100% Tempranillo grapes grown on the limestone slopes of the Hoces del Río Riaza Natural Park at 954 meters above sea level. The vineyards lie on stony, calcareous soils with excellent drainage, providing concentration and character.

The harvest is carried out manually in 20 kg boxes. At the winery, the grapes pass through a sorting table, are destemmed and manually checked. Vat filling is done by gravity and fermentation takes place with indigenous yeasts, with daily pump-overs to gently extract aromas and smoothness. Malolactic fermentation is followed by 6 months of ageing in French oak barrels.

Appearance

Deep cherry red colour with violet highlights. Clean and bright, with a medium-high intensity that suggests vibrancy and good concentration.

Nose

Fresh and expressive, dominated by red fruit (strawberry, cherry) and dried herbs. The oak adds light notes of creamy wood, toast and spices, with a slightly balsamic background.

Palate

Shows restrained ripeness, good freshness and balance. Juicy and flavourful, with fine tannins and a silky texture.

A limited-edition Tempranillo sourced from the single vineyard “El Arenal”, located in the heart of the Hoces del Río Riaza Natural Park at 950 metres above sea level. Carefully aged and crafted with patience, this wine reveals depth, complexity and elegance, faithfully reflecting the character of the landscape where it is born. The altitude, the calcareous soils and the low yields of the vineyard contribute to its concentration, freshness and distinctive personality.

Tasting Notes

Appearance

Very intense cherry red colour, clean and bright, with a deep, high layer that anticipates concentration, structure and great ageing potential.

Nose

Complex and expressive. Spicy notes intertwine with a distinctive mineral character and a marked presence of ripe black fruit. Subtle hints of fine oak, cocoa and balsamic nuances add depth and elegance, with excellent aromatic definition.

Palate

Elegant, full-bodied and well-structured on the palate, with polished tannins and perfectly integrated acidity. Broad and enveloping, it shows remarkable balance and precision, leading to a long and persistent finish that leaves a refined and lasting impression.

Murón Verdejo de Altura 2024



Grape Variety

100% Verdejo, sourced from high-altitude vineyards that enhance freshness, aromatic intensity and natural balance.

Alcohol

14% Vol.

Appearance

Bright wine with a pale yellow colour and greenish highlights, showing great clarity and a youthful, vibrant character.

Nose

High aromatic intensity with an expressive profile. Notes of tropical fruit are combined with classic Verdejo hints of fennel, fresh herbs and subtle floral nuances, creating a fresh and elegant bouquet.

Palate

Refreshing and well-balanced, with lively acidity that provides tension and length. The characteristic slightly bitter finish of the variety adds personality and makes the wine especially gastronomic.

Production

Limited production of 2,000 bottles.

Food Pairing

An excellent match for fish, seafood, cured ham, pasta dishes, chicken and cold meats. Its freshness also makes it ideal as an aperitif or for light Mediterranean cuisine.

Serving Temperature

Serve between 8° and 10° C.

Murón Albillo Mayor 2022· Centenary Vines

White wine aged on lees · Limited production

Origin

Made from centenary Albillo Mayor vines traditionally planted among Tempranillo in the family vineyards of the Hoces del Río Riaza Natural Park. These scattered and sometimes “hidden” white vines are a vestige of the region’s historical viticulture. Grown at 900 meters above sea level on calcareous, stony soils with excellent drainage, they provide tension, vibrancy and a marked mineral character.

Winemaking

The harvest is carried out manually in 20 kg boxes, selecting only the bunches with optimal ripeness. At the winery, the grapes pass through a sorting table, are destemmed and manually checked to preserve only the essential fruit. The must is obtained by gentle pressing and transferred by gravity into stainless steel tanks, where it ferments spontaneously with indigenous yeasts, respecting the identity of the vineyard and its ecosystem. After alcoholic fermentation, the wine ages on fine lees in French oak barrels for several months, with periodic bâtonnage to increase volume, creaminess and aromatic complexity without losing freshness. Production is limited and the wine is bottled without haste, when it reaches its natural balance.

Tasting Notes

Appearance: Bright, clean golden colour with reflections that convey freshness and a delicate body. **Nose:** Intense and enveloping. Creamy oak, stone fruit and tropical fruit, pastry notes and fine lees. **Palate:** Structured, flavourful and balanced, with good breadth and texture. Spiced and fruity nuances, and a long, persistent finish with an elegant presence of lees and subtle oak.

Food Pairing

Fish, creamy rice dishes, roasted vegetables, soft cheeses, delicate stews and traditional Castilian cuisine. Its volume and balance also allow it to pair with more powerful dishes such as torreznos or meats in sauce.
